Catalyst Tools allow you to:

- Join an online discussion – **GoPost**
 - Turn in homework online – **CollectIt**
 - Take or make an online survey – **WebQ**
 - Share files with others – **ShareSpaces**
 - Collect and reflect on documents – **Portfolio**
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- Manage groups that use the tools you make – **Group Manager**
 - Make a web site – **SimpleSite**
 - Respond to a short poll – **QuickPoll**
 - Participate in a case study – **VirtualCase**
 - Comment on others' work – **Peer Review**
 - Send anonymous feedback - **Umail**

Exercise 2 – Using GoPost

- Write a message
- Look at who else is participating
- If you have time, change your profile

Exercise 3 – Creating a GoPost

- Get into groups of three, with one person as the designated “board owner” – other students will look on
- Board owners, go to the Catalyst web site
- Click on **Web Tools Login** and type in your UW NetID and password
- Click on GoPost on the left hand side
- Click on **Create new board**

Exercise 3 – creating a GoPost

- Board owners, type in a name for your board
- Note that there are two styles of boards
- Choose **One list of conversations** and save it
- The management screen opens

Exercise 3 – creating a GoPost

- Look for the **Availability** section at the bottom and click on the **Edit** link in that section
- On the new page, choose **Open**, then save
- Share the URL on this page with your group mates
- Go to the board as a group and try things out!

- Attach a file
